This week we celebrate the feast of St. Luke the Evangelist, (Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>) writer of one of the four Gospels. It is because of St. Luke alone that we have many of our familiar biblical accounts, such as the Annunciation, the Visitation, the Prodigal Son, the Good Samaritan, and the account of the sisters Mary and Martha to name a few. Luke begins his Gospel addressing it to Dear Theophilus, which means friend of God. This week be that friend of God, and pick up your Bible turning to Luke once each day, reading it as his letter to you. Read it from the perspective of the heart of a friend speaking to your heart, about who Jesus is for him, and who he wishes Him to be for you.
