The Vatican has announced a rosary initiative dedicating the month of May to prayer for an end to the coronavirus pandemic.

Thirty Catholic shrines around the world will take turns leading a daily rosary. The official channels of the Holy See will broadcast the prayer said each day in each of these thirty Shrines at 1:00 p.m. our time. All Catholics are invited to participate in the daily rosaries. However, if you can't join them virtually make an

effort to at least one day of the week join them spiritually by saying a rosary alone or with your family for an end to the Corona Virus.
