PRACTICE makes PERFECT (Matt. 5:48)

We have been reading snippets, from the 6th Chapter of John from the past number of weeks, where Jesus is giving what is known as the 'Bread of Life Discourse'. But as always happens when you break things up, we

can lose some of the impact of what is being said. This week, pick up your Bible and read through the whole 6th chapter of John in one sitting. Prayerfully place yourself into the scene as one of the crowd that day. Imagine listening to him... imagine seeing the other people's reactions... imagine Jesus looking directly at you as if you were the only two in the crowd that day, who knew exactly what he was speaking about in the gift he was going to give us of himself in the Eucharist. Imagine what you would say to him, then tell him next time you see him at Mass.
