Make sure to mark this Thursday evening, March 30th on your calendar. At All Saints, at 7:00 p.m. we will be celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation. We will have extra priests on hand to help hear confessions.

PRACTICE makes PERFECT (Matt. 5:48)

One of the greatest ways we can prepare for the upcoming Easter feasts is to make a good confession. This Thursday there is a great opportunity with extra priests on hand at All Saints parish. In preparation for confession, one should make a good examination of conscience. Many can be found online, but there is also another great way, and that is with the Scriptures. There are numerous passages one can read through but I will suggest three. The first is the commandments found in the book of Deuteronomy chapter 5 verses 6–21; the sermon on the mount found in Matthew chapters 5-7; and St. Paul's discussion on Christian love found in 1 Corinthians chapter 13 verses 1-7. These passages should give some good food for thought on what we

might want to bring to the Lord for our forgiveness and healing.
