### DIOCESAN COMMUNITY NEWS

As of April 11, the general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will come to an end. Of course, we still encourage people to stay home if they are sick and remind everyone that "*no one is bound to the impossible.*" We would also like to remind the faithful that their pastor can dispense them from the Sunday obligation or substitute it with another pious act (such as praying with scripture) for a just cause. This dispensation or substitution can be granted for as long as the cause continues. **The purpose of the obligation is to respect the importance of celebrating the Lord's Day in prayer.**

**All are invited to "Prayer for Palliative Care":** It is the annual prayer led by the CWL councils of St. George's and All Saints to remember the dying, their family members, those close to them, and those who care for them, as we respect all life from conception to natural death. This year it will be held on Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, The Feast Day of Our Lady of Fatima.
