Along with the change here in our parishes here are the other clergy changes in the Diocese: The following appointments are effective June 23 - Fr. Albin Arsenaault named Pastor of St. Augustine (Rustico) and Administrator of St Anne's (Hope River) and Stella Maris (North Rustico).

- Fr. Dovari Joseph has completed his term in the Diocese of Charlottetown and his bishop is arranging a new assignment.

- Fr. Lazaru Panthagani named Pastor of Immaculate Conception (Palmer Road); Administrator of St.

Anthony's (Bloomfield), Corpus Christi (Glenwood), Immaculate Conception (Brae), St. Brigid's (Foxley River).

- Fr. Maurice Praught will retire from active ministry.

- Fr. Arulraj Santiago named Pastor of Holy Redeemer (Charlottetown).

As of April 11, the general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will come to an end.
