Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the Beatitudes we heard last week, Jesus spells out the standard of holiness expected of those whose lives are conformed to his life. This is very great: far beyond what we are capable of achieving on our own. In the Beatitudes, Jesus speaks of what is promised to those who belong to him. Their rewards, their happiness, he says, also will be very great. Now today we hear what follows in the Sermon on the Mount: two sayings about Salt and Light. Here Jesus makes clear what is the mission, the vocation, the task and responsibility of those who live according to the Beatitudes. This also is very great. Jesus used ordinary images, such as salt and light, to convey extraordinary truths that transform our minds, hearts, and lives.

Jesus used the image of salt to describe the transforming effect of God's work in our lives – and how the Holy Spirit wants to work through us to bring the power and blessing of God's kingdom to others. How do we become salt and light to other people?
