12th Sunday in Ordinary Time Reflection

In today's gospel, Jesus repeated three times, "Do not be afraid" as He sends His apostles to preach the Kingdom of God to a world full of hostility. He knew very well the weaknesses and strengths of the people He is sending. There are enough reasons to be afraid. Missionaries are not welcomed in many parts of the world. Preachers and priests are martyred. Even ordinary Christians are ridiculed and persecuted by forces seen and unseen.

Can humanity overcome all of these troubles? Jesus is telling us, do not be afraid. Though the world seems to be in darkness, God who created it is in control. He sees everything including our secrets. He knows everything including the numbers of our hair. He can do anything and no one is above Him!

Do not be afraid. Though our fear seems to grow bigger, we have a God who is bigger. He is the God of history. God loves us as to make us. He loves us as to redeem us when we got lost due to sin. As He sent His apostles before, He is sending us now to bring the Good News to a world that is full of betrayal and enveloped by darkness. Let us never be afraid.
