### Most Holy Trinity Sunday

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the feast of the Triune God manifested in three persons: the Father, Son and the Spirit. In our practice of Christian Life, the Trinity is remembered often in prayer and during the daily routine by every Christian.

Each time we make the sign of the cross, as we do at the beginning of every celebration, we say: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." In the second reading of today Paul reminds the people of the Father's love, the grace that comes through Jesus Christ and the fellowship or the unifying power of the Holy Spirit.

The intimate relationship between the Father, Son and the Spirit is described in various places in the Gospel of John. The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity consists of this: the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three gods, but only one God with three attributes. We have the Father who is the creator, the Son who is the redeemer and the Holy Spirit who is the sanctifier and the counselor.

So, we are created in love to be a community of loving persons, just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are united in Love. From the day of our Baptism, we are belonged to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. How privileged we are to grow up in such a beautiful Family! Hence, let us turn to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in prayer every day.
