Transfiguration of the Lord Time Reflection

The first verse of the gospel reading states that Jesus led Peter, James, and John to a high mountain. If we accept that Jesus is our Lord, Savior and King, we allow Him to lead us to where we should go. We are no longer in control of our life but we surrender to the prompting of the Holy Spirit.

In our day to day decision-making, we pray that Jesus will manifest His will to us and that we may have the humility and willingness to follow Him. Saint Dunstan's University Bursary: Students are reminded that there has been a change to the SDU Bursary program- beginning with the 2023-2024 academic years the SDU Bursary will increase in value to \$1,500. Application form and criteria are available on the Saint Dunstan's University website, https://saintdunstansuniversity.ca Application deadline is August 31, 2023. A maximum of 175 bursaries will be awarded for the coming academic year. Also note that the SDU Board of Governors High School award has been discontinued. As many schools may not have administrative staff during July and August you are advised to make arrangements to have your transcript sent prior to the end of June.

Connolly Estate Bursaries are open to residents of PEI who can demonstrate that they are Roman Catholic, are Irish in heritage, and have material financial need. Applicants must be a full-time student enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited university.

College students who are completing a joint program / degree must be enrolled in the university portion of their studies to be eligible. If you are under age 22 as of August 31, your income and your parent's income will be used to assess financial need. If you are 22 or older, only the applicant's income is used to assess financial need. Recent bursaries have been in the \$2,000 range but vary depending on investment returns and number of successful applicants. Apply at www.OwenConnollyestate.com. Successful applicants will be notified on December 15. Deadline to apply is August 31.
