### **26th Sunday in Ordinary Time Reflection**

Jesus was speaking to the Israelites especially to the religious authorities. They were the first to receive the word of God through the prophets. They claimed to believe in the one and only God but their faith was mostly expressed in their lips yet their action did not go with their words. They were just like the second son in the gospel reading today.

On the other hand, the so-called sinners, the prostitutes and the tax collectors, who became followers of John the Baptists and Jesus Christ, listened and repented and therefore, they have the passport to enter the Kingdom of God. They were like the first son who initially said no but eventually obeyed his father.

In Matthew 15:8, Jesus quotes Isaiah 29:13 saying "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." Also in Matthew 7:21-23, He specifically warns that "Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord!' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of My Father in heaven." Therefore more importantly, let our words be translated into action. Better yet, let our action of loving others speak for itself.
