27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Reflection

The tenants in the gospel reading today refer to the religious leaders such as the Scribes and the Pharisees in ancient Israel who were tasked to take care of the people of God. Yet they did not live up to what was expected of them. On the other hand, the servants refer to the prophets whom they rejected and even murdered. Of course, Jesus was the Son of God whom they also rejected and later crucified.

This parable of the tenants teaches us that being a messenger of the truth is not easy. Many people are uncomfortable with it. That is why history is filled with stories of prophets and missionaries who were martyred for their work as messengers about the truth about God and His son Jesus. Yet Jesus Himself, as the stone rejected by the builders, has become the cornerstone of the Kingdom of God project and this project is still being constructed.

Like Jesus and the prophets before Him and the apostles after Him, let us have enough courage to continue building the Kingdom of God. We may be criticized, opposed and even murdered, but let us keep on working in order for the vineyard to keep producing fruits for the glory of God.
