2nd Sunday in Advent

A sinful man promised God that he would repent and walk away from anything that make him sin. He was able to walk away from his sinfulness for a period of time until he sinned again and again and again.

It's very easy to say that we would not sin again but when the temptation to sin beckons many of us are helpless against it. So, we sin again until sinning becomes a part of our lifestyle until these many sins become our ticket to wretchedness.

When John appeared from the wilderness he preached repentance and many listened to him. They went to John to repent and be baptized including the Pharisees and Sadducees. Were the Pharisees and Sadducees sincere in their desire for repentance? No, they were not; it was a superficial repentance this was primarily the reason why John rebuked them. John wanted the Pharisees and Sadducees to produce concrete evidence of their repentance. John wanted an interior, genuine and deep repentance from them.
