### 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Advent

Are we obedient to the will of God?

When Joseph discovered that Mary was pregnant, he decided to quietly separate from her—quietly, because that was his character. He was a quiet and humble man. As much as possible, Joseph did not want to create a scene that could result in Mary's being excluded by her townspeople. Perhaps the devil was already constantly trying to provoke Joseph to do something that would humiliate Mary. But Joseph calmly resisted whatever evil plots the devil had. He overcame them by listening to what the angel told him to do.

Thus, Joseph faithfully loved and protected his family. By his act of obedience to the will of God, we can safely conclude that Joseph loved Mary deeply.
